RESOLUTION NO. 2017-7

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KENNETT, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE KENNETT TOWNSHIP ZONING HEARING BOARD FROM THREE (3) TO FIVE (5) MEMBERS, APPOINTING TWO (2) NEW MEMBERS TO THE KENNETT TOWNSHIP ZONING HEARING BOARD AND DESIGNATING THEIR INITIAL TERMS OF OFFICE; REPEALING ALL INCONSISTNT RESOLUTIONS OF PARTS THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township has established the Kennett Township Zoning Hearing Board which consists of three (3) members; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Kennett Township to increase the membership of the Kennett Township Zoning Hearing Board from three (3) to five (5) members, as permitted by Section 903(a) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. §10903; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to appoint two (2) new members to the Kennett Township Zoning Hearing Board and fix their initial terms of office;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township, and it is hereby **ADOPTED** and **RESOLVED** by authority of same as follows:

I. The Kennett Township Zoning Hearing Board is expanded from three (3) to five (5) members.

II. The following persons are newly appointed as members of the Kennett Township Zoning Hearing Board with initial terms expiring as follows:

John Haedrich	December 31, 2021
Robert Whipps	December 31, 2020

III. The following persons are appointed as members of the Kennett Township Zoning Hearing Board with terms expiring as follows:

Lee Fulton	December 31, 2019
Elizabeth C. Swain	December 31, 2018
Peter Murphy	December 31, 2017

III. All resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.


IV. The provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Resolution is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Resolution, which shall continue in full force and effect.

V. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its legal adoption.
