RESOLUTION NO. 2018-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KENNETT, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2001-7 IN ITS ENTIRETY; REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2001, the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township adopted Resolution No. 2001-7 which implemented fines for the violation of Ordinance No. 96 entitled "Alarm Registration Ordinance"; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2018, the Board of Supervisors repealed Ordinance No. 96, as codified as Chapter 67 of the Code of Ordinances of Kennett Township; and


WHEREAS, in the wake of the repeal of Ordinance No. 96, the Board of Supervisors desires to repeal the fines that were implemented for violation of Ordinance No. 96 as no longer being necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township, and it is hereby **ADOPTED** and **RESOLVED** by authority of same as follows:

- I. Resolution No. 2001-7 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- II. All resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.
- IV. The provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Resolution is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Resolution.
- V. This Resolution shall become effective five (5) days following its legal enactment.





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
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
