**KENNETT TOWNSHIP

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING EMERGENCY SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR KENNETT TOWNSHIP EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2021 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2021.

WHEREAS, Kennett Township is responsible under the Second Class Township Code for the public safety of the residents of Kennett Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Chester has requested that Kennett Township provide a resolution outlining the methods and agencies chosen to fulfill the public safety needs of Kennett Township for the efficient administration of the integrated emergency communications system of the Chester County Department of Emergency Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Kennett Fire Company and Longwood Fire Company will provide fire and rescue protection.

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED the Longwood Fire Company will provide ambulance services; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that Longwood Fire Company provide Advanced Life Support Services; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED the Kennett Township Police Department will provide full time police protection; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that Jeffrey Hammaker is designated as Emergency Management Coordinator; and

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors have reviewed and revised, if necessary, and adopted Kennett Township's Emergency Operations Plan; and has reviewed and adopted the National Incident Management System as a common operating practice.

AND FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, the contact person(s) between said organizations and the Chester County Department of Emergency Services shall be Eden Ratliff.




