SUBJECT: June 17, 2021 – July 16, 2021 Department Head Report

1. Drainage repairs were completed at several locations in the Township along with head wall work on Cold Springs Drive.
2. We installed a new inlet box and pipe on Sills Mill Road. Temporary paving is in place and will be completed when we finish the other pipe jobs in the next few weeks.
3. A surprise luncheon was given to me (Roger Lysle) at the Township building for my 40th year with the Township. Neighboring Townships, staff, and my family attended. I would like to thank everyone who pulled this off. I feel very blessed to have been part of a great group. Coming to work has always been fun for me. The residents and Township just feel like family.
4. Storm damage around the Township was limited to tree damage from rain and wind. All was cleaned up in time for traffic to flow, but there are still some large sections of trees that need to be hauled away.
5. Hillendale Road was closed overnight due to wire being pulled down. PECO came to cut open and repair wires and had the road opened by morning rush. Our crew finished cleaning up.
6. Update on Route 82 & Cedarcroft Road light upgrade: The holdup is the delivery of material. They expect delivery in a couple weeks for the traffic light poles. Once they are delivered, they will start the project.
7. Our second round of mowing is underway and should be completed next week.
8. We completed several pump station repairs and maintenance.
9. Our yard waste pile continues to grow, and our metal recycling dumpster is being dumped once a month. This is really working well for us. The price for scrap is up so we are getting about \$500 per dumpster.
10. We are hoping to fill our open job position on the road crew soon. Many applications are being reviewed and interviews should start soon.
