SUBJECT: July 21, 2021 – August 13, 2021 Department Head Report

---

1. Our crews cleaned up from recent pop-up storms. Many roads had limbs come down and a few trees, but the crews have been able to keep the roads open. This left a lot of wood for chipping.
2. We trimmed the trees throughout the entire subdivision of Knoxlyn Farms.
3. Township crews have been painting our stop bars, crosswalks, and railroad crossings. Our paint supply is backordered, but we will finish once the supply is back in stock.
4. Our surface treatment program for 2021 was completed on sections of Center Mill Road and Hillendale Road. We applied oil and chip surface, then swept, and then applied a fog seal to lock in the stone.
5. New drainpipes and inlet boxes were installed on Burrows Run Road and Bayard Road. We will let them settle for two weeks and then we will pave the surface. There are still two other pipe jobs to complete, but again we are waiting for backordered product to arrive.
6. Our eight Township-owned pumps stations were all cleaned and pumped out by our crews and an outside contractor. This is done three times a year to remove sludge, grease, and material. This maintenance helps to prolong the life of the pumps and help prevent future problems.
7. A new employee was hired for our Public Works Road Crew. Daniel Tracy will join our team starting August 23<sup>rd</sup>. He comes with past municipal experience and knowledge, and we are looking forward to adding him to our great team.
8. Recycling update: We are asking our residents to please review the signs posted on what is allowed and not allowed to be dropped off (also pictured on the following pages). The yard waste pile and our metal dumpster are having lots of trash and other items that don't belong in them. This is causing problems with our contractors and will affect future cost and possible times for dumping.
