

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-17**

**KENNETT TOWNSHIP  
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**A RESOLUTION OF KENNETT TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, LEVYING TAXES ON REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN KENNETT TOWNSHIP FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021; REPEALING ALL INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS THEREOF; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township is authorized to levy taxes upon all real property within Kennett Township made taxable for Township purposes, as ascertained by the last adjusted valuation for county purposes, pursuant to Section 3205(a) of the Second-Class Township Code, 53 P.S. Section 68205(a); and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township desires to levy real estate taxes as authorized by the Second-Class Township Code for general Township purposes for fiscal year 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township has determined that such a tax levy is in the best interests of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of Kennett Township in order to allow the Township to provide services to its residents in 2022;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it, and it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Kennett Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ADOPTED** and **RESOLVED** by authority of same as follows:

- I. The following taxes are levied upon all real property within Kennett Township made taxable for Township purposes as ascertained by the last adjusted valuation for county purposes for fiscal year 2022:

	<u>Mills on each dollar of assessed valuation for land</u>	<u>Cents on each one hundred dollars of assessed valuation for land</u>
Tax rate for General Purposes	2.3 mills	23.00 cents
1995 Library Tax by Referendum	0.2 mills	2.00 cents

- II. All resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

III. The provisions of this Resolution are declared to be severable. If any provision of this Resolution is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

IV. This Resolution shall become effective on January 1, 2022.
