SUBJECT: December 10, 2021 – January 13, 2022 Department Head Report

1. Tree trimming is underway on clear days. So far, the Hammorton cut off, Woodchuck Way, Hillingham, and Farm Lane were completed. Burrows Run Road will be next.
2. At the Rosedale Road Pump Station, a blower motor was pulled, repaired, then replaced. At the Richardson Pump Station, the backup pump was pulled after and in plant pump was fixed and reinstalled.
3. The new traffic light at Cedarcroft Road and Route 82 has now been installed, tested and is in full operation. Please pay attention during the next month while the public learns the new traffic pattern.
4. After about one wee of work, the yard waste pile was ground and hauled out a little at a time. The total tonnage is not known yet, but it will be on the bill when that comes in. It should be close to 1,000 tons like it was last time.
5. Drainage work was done on Chandler Mill/Bucktoe culvert to fix swales and remove blockage on the inlet side.
6. Potholes were repaired on Spring Mill Road after many complaints from residents were reported. It was reported to PennDOT but due to their crew having COVID-19, the Township helped them out to make it safe.
7. Our first snowfall came on January 3<sup>rd</sup>. Crews only had to salt for this storm. Two more snow events came on January 7<sup>th</sup> and January 10<sup>th</sup>, and both were taken care of by our Road Crew.
8. Salt was ordered and delivered to restock the salt barn before the next storm.
9. The meadow behind the Township office was recently mowed. This is done when the ground is frozen so that we don't get stuck or make ruts in the soft areas.
