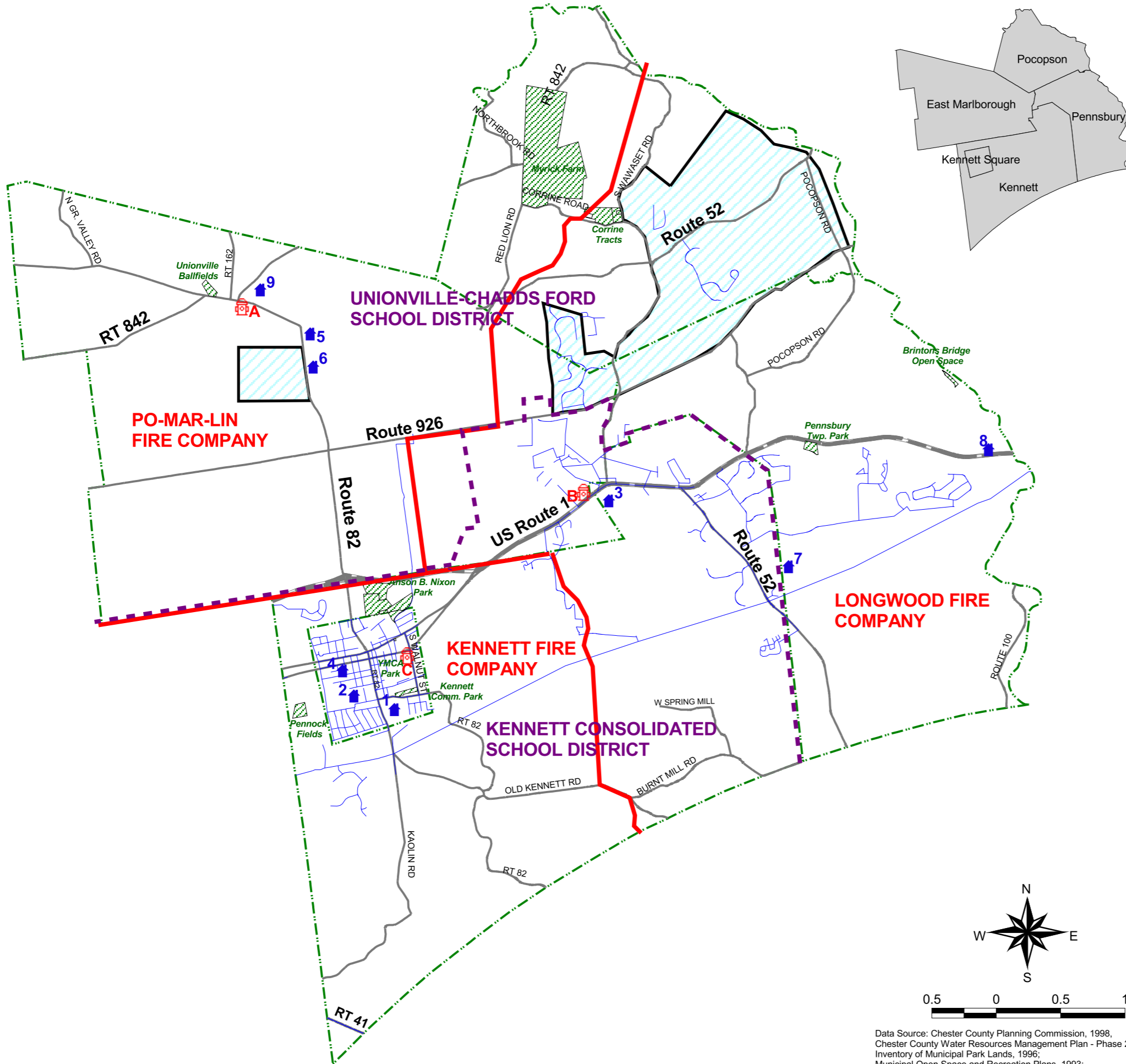


Map 7-1: Community Facilities Map
