3/30/23: Crew's from Longwood, Kennett and Po-Mar-Lin responded to multiple electrical emergencies in homes along Osbourne Cir and



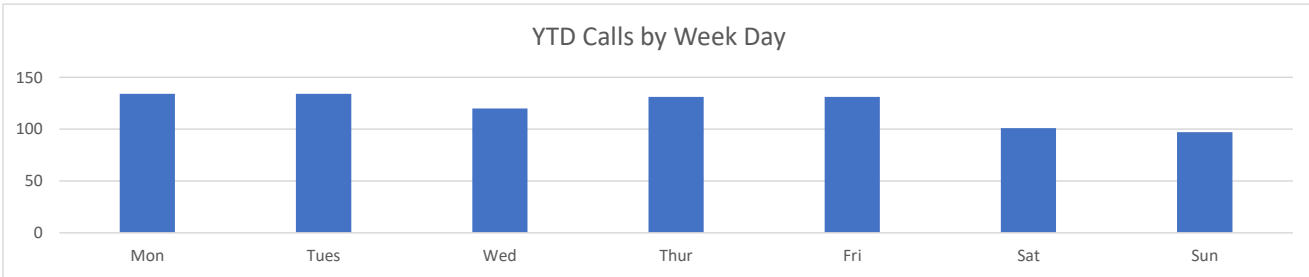
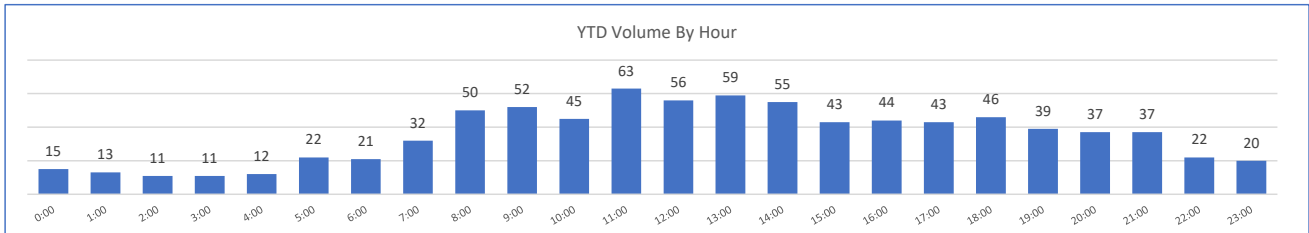
