- Rt 52 and Rt 926 also is beginning to be a reoccurring location for motor vehicle collisions.



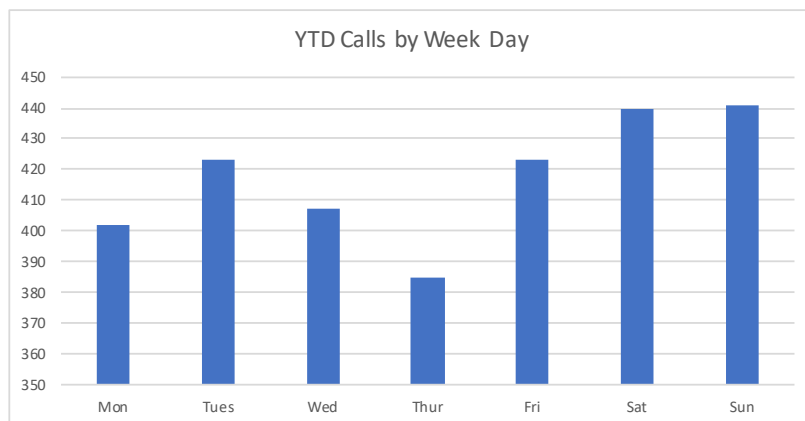
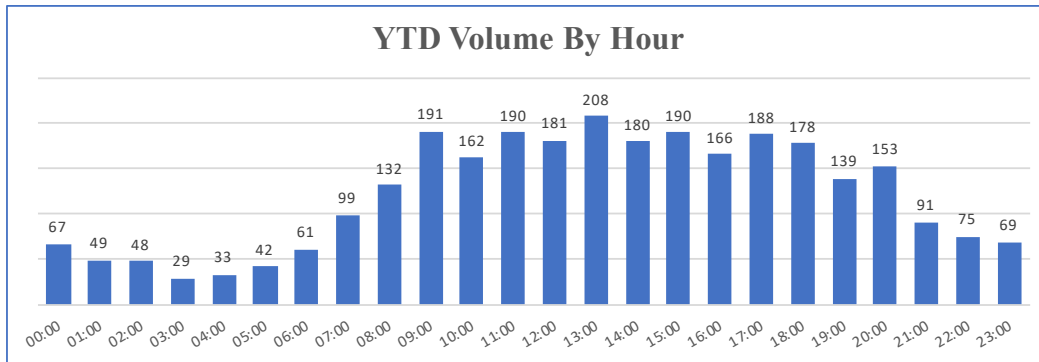
